## Adapted Physical Education Workshop

**October 19, 2011**

This workshop, sponsored by Assabet Valley Collaborative and Perkins Training Center is designed for Special Education professionals working with students of all ages with vision loss including those with additional disabilities. This workshop will address teaching, designing and modifying physical education and recreation skills. Specific teaching methods for modifying activities and progressing through activities will be addressed. A portion of the workshop will focus on planning and accessing community based recreational activities. This workshop will be conducted by Matt LaCortiglia of the Perkins School for the Blind and will include video and live activity demonstrations of physical education and physically active recreational activities. Participants will have the opportunity to participate in group discussion and mock scenarios.

- Participants will be able identify numerous games, sports, and physically active recreational opportunities that match their students interest, abilities, and needs.
- Participants will be able to determine modifications, accommodations, and specially designed instruction for successful participation in physically active recreational games, and sports.
- Participants will be knowledgeable of three main ideas in evaluating student participation in physically active recreational games, and sports.
