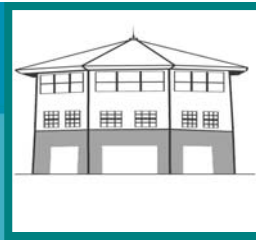

This weekend workshop will immerse you in BrailleNote, highlighting its use in the school environment. You will learn the command structure and basic operation of the main application programs and you will learn how to teach use of the device to your students.

- Learn methods for transferring various school documents between BrailleNote and a PC
- Navigate through the menus and sub-menus of the BrailleNote software
- Perform basic tasks in the Word Processor and Book Reader on the BrailleNote
- Perform basic operations using the scientific calculator & learn audio functions such as the voice recorder, MP3 player.
