The Center for Assistive Technology Training (CATT)

The Center for Assistive Technology Training (CATT) Project is a collaboration between the Alabama Institute for the Deaf and Blind (AIDB) and the American Printing House for the Blind (APH). Our goal through this program is to pair the provision of assistive technology devices to students who are Blind/Visually Impaired with training. This training is for the student using the devices, the teachers working with the students and the family members that are a part of the student's life. Devices are purchased through APH and training is provided through AIDB employed trainers. The CATT project is charged with working in a nine state region which includes Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee.
