# What is Project INSPIRE?

Project INSPIRE is a 5 year training grant to support braille literacy for professionals and students to build their skills and knowledge in the braille codes for STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics) courses.

# What is a focus group and how will the research be run?

# Who is eligible to participate in the focus groups?

- Students who are in grades 6 to 12 and have been reading braille for more than 6 years
- Students must be using braille in math and science classes
- Students must be comfortable talking in a group setting
